








e-dealing & Instrument Status Icons

e-dealings and instruments change status as they progress through the Conveyancing Process. You can tell the status of an *e-dealing* or instrument by the icon that displays next to it.

Icon	Description
 Draft	The Draft icon displays when an <i>e-dealing</i> or instrument has been created, and when an instrument has been prepared.
 Signed	The Signed icon displays when an instrument has been certified and signed.
 Part Signed	The Part Signed icon displays when an instrument that has not been signed by all Conveyancing Professionals (CPs) listed. This displays when at least one, but not all parties have signed an instrument,
 Released	The Released icon displays when an instrument is released, or when all instruments in an <i>e-dealing</i> have been released.
 Rejected	The Rejected icon displays when an <i>e-dealing</i> has failed registration because it has been rejected or refused. The <i>e-dealing</i> will display with a new dealing number. Note: This icon also displays for <i>e-dealings</i> that are withdrawn.
 Lodged	The Lodged icon displays for the Lodged folder and for an <i>e-dealing</i> (in this folder) that has been submitted but not yet registered (ie a LODGE or a queued AUTO REG <i>e-dealing</i>).
 Requisitioned	The Requisitioned icon displays for the Requisitioned folder and for a requisitioned <i>e-dealing</i> in this folder.
